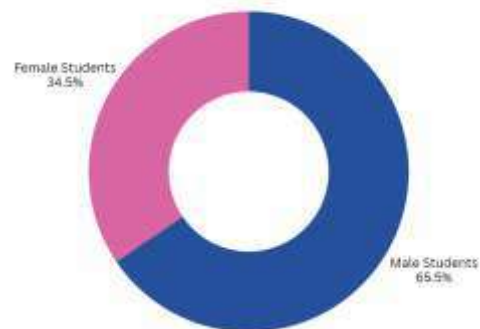

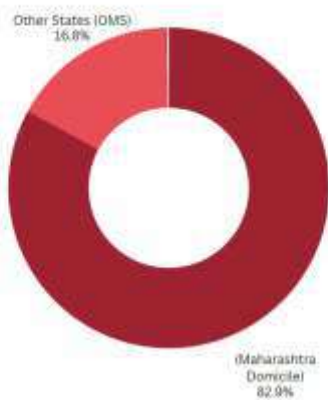
State and Gender wise Domiciled Students Details for A.Y. 2024-25

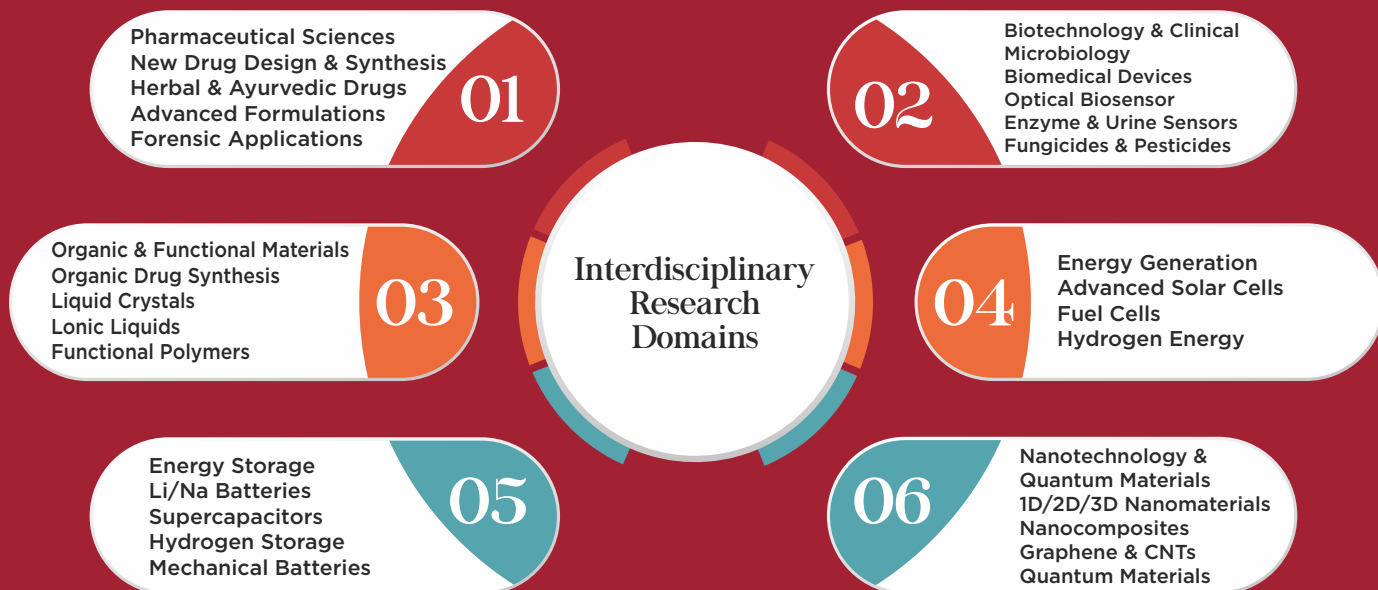
Integrating Research and Skills : PCU's Pathway to Academic, Industrial, and Entrepreneurial Growth"

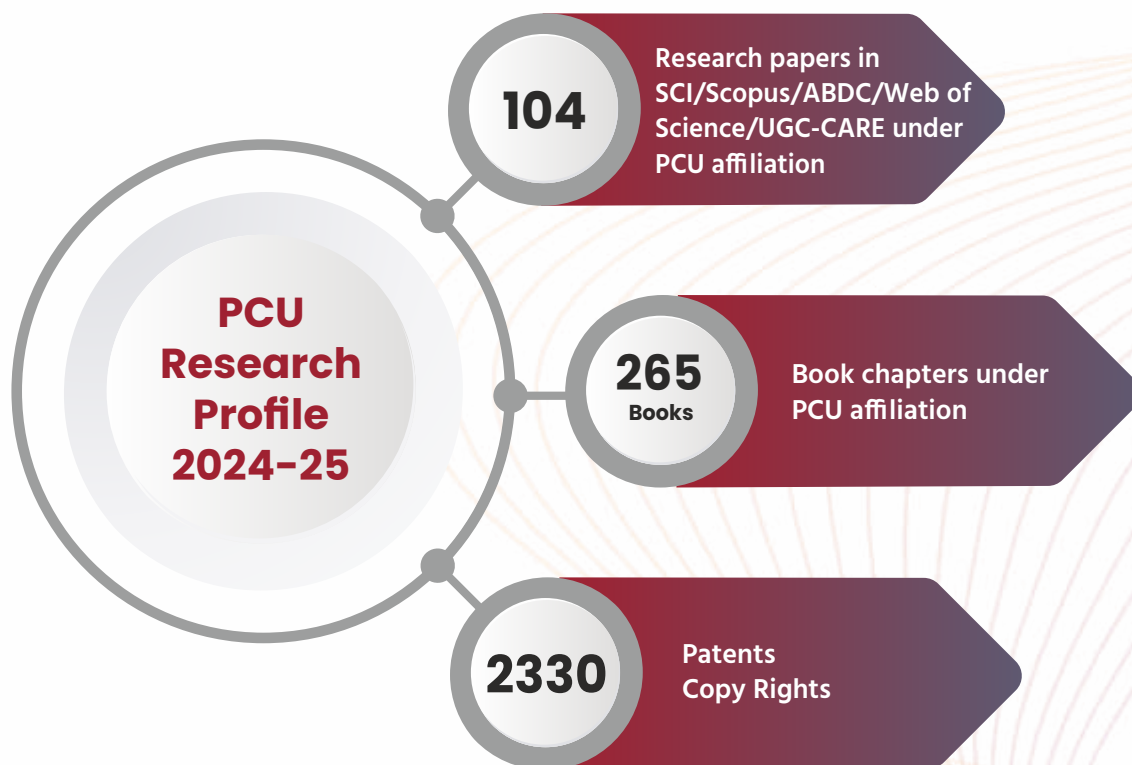

The facility will enable fabrication of devices such as lithium-ion batteries, capacitors, solar cells, and sensors, while offering comprehensive characterization tools like XRD, FESEM, HPLC, and GC, supported by robust simulation capabilities integrated with AI/ML. With foreign universities and industries PCU is already having collaboration. The centre will open by 24/ and serve as a hub for fundamental, applied, and industry-driven research, positioning PCU as a leader in innovation and global partnerships.
